Tour du Canada — Vancouver to St. John's, June 26 - September 5 — a 10-week cross-country trip in the *coureur de bois* tradition that travels through all 10 provinces.

7,665 kilometres (4,730 miles), daily average 130 kilometres (80 miles). \$4,175.00
59 ride days, 12 rest days, all meals, 62 nights camping, 11 indoors, 3 ferry crossings.

Tour Arctic — Vancouver to Inuvik, July 19 - August 12 — through Vancouver Island and by ferry to Skagway, then north to Whitehorse, Dawson and beyond the Arctic Circle.

1,935 kilometres (1,195 miles), daily average 102 km. (63 mi.), 19 ride days, 5 rest days. \$3,795.00
20 nights camping, 5 nights indoor, 20 breakfasts, 20 dinners, 2 major ferry crossings.

Tour Atlantic — Halifax to Baddeck, August 15 - August 29 — the Nova Scotia south shore to the Annapolis Valley to New Brunswick's Fundy region to P.E.I. and the Cabot Trail.

1,320 kilometres (815 miles), daily average 110 km. (68 mi.), 12 ride days, 2 rest days. \$1,395.00
11 nights camping, 4 nights indoor, 11 breakfasts, 12 dinners, 2 ferry crossings.

Tour Pacific — Vancouver to Calgary via the Icefields Parkway, July 2 - July 16 — from dense coastal forest to cattle country to high mountains and alpine meadows.

1,310 kilometres (810 miles), daily average 108 km (67 mi.), 12 ride days, 2 rest days, 11 breakfasts, 12 dinners. Camping option: 12 nights camping, 3 nights indoor. \$1,395.00
Indoor option: 14 nights indoor, but call for details. \$2,095.00

The BiQue Ride — Toronto to Montreal, July 11 - July 17 — along Lake Ontario and the St. Lawrence River through Empire Loyalist country and old canal routes Quebec.

660 kilometres (410 miles), daily average 110 km. (68 mi.), 6 ride days, 1 rest day. \$825.00
7 nights indoor, 6 breakfasts, 1 dinner.

The By-Cycle Ride — Toronto to Bytown (now called Ottawa), August 8 - August 13 — follow the Rideau Canal, a historic water route with roots in the War of 1812.

510 kilometres (315 miles), daily average 103 km. (63 mi.), 5 ride days. \$795.00
6 nights indoor, 5 breakfasts, 1 dinner.

Cabot Trail — Charlottetown to Baddeck, August 24 - August 29 — the Birthplace of Confederation, hills and ocean views as far as the eye can see. A Down East Classic.

590 kilometres (365 miles), daily average 118 km. (73 mi.), 5 ride days. \$695.00
2 nights indoor, 4 nights camping, 5 breakfasts, 5 dinners.

Fall Colours — Alliston to Niagara Falls, October 4 - October 8 — along the Nottawasaga and Grand River watersheds through Mennonite country to a natural wonder of the world.

420 kilometres (260 miles), daily average 83 km. (51 mi.), 5 ride days. \$675.00
5 nights indoors, 5 breakfasts, 1 dinner.

Icefields Parkway — Jasper to Calgary, July 12 - July 16 — past glacial melt that flows to the Pacific and Arctic Oceans and then to Lake Louise and Banff.

435 kilometres (270 miles), daily average 108 km. (67 mi.), 4 ride days. \$625.00
1 nights indoors, 4 nights camping, 4 breakfasts, 4 dinners.

Voyageur Route — Ottawa to Quebec City, July 25 - July 30 — along the Ottawa, Richelieu and St. Lawrence Rivers, ancient canoe routes to the continental interior.

545 kilometres (335 miles), daily average 109 km. (67 mi.), 5 ride days. \$795.00
6 nights indoors, 5 breakfasts, 1 dinner.

Southern Ontario Century Ride — A warm-up weekend ride, May 29 -30, Toronto to Alliston and return, or loops from Alliston. Choice of 100 kilometres or 100 miles out and back.

1 night indoor, 1 dinner 1 breakfast. \$125.00 1 night cabin, 1 dinner, 1 breakfast. \$89.00
